Install the imaging unit

CAUTION:

Leave the front and right doors open until all installation steps are complete.

1. Remove the imaging unit from the shipping bag and place it on a clean flat surface.

Figure : Remove the imaging unit from the shipping bag




2. Loosen the shipping tape from the bottom and both sides of the imaging unit.

Figure : Loosen the shipping tape on the imaging unit



3. Remove the orange shipping locks from the imaging unit. Figure : Remove the orange shipping locks



4. Remove the remaining shipping tape and carefully pull the protective sheet from the imaging unit.

Figure : Remove remaining tape and pull out the protective sheet



NOTE:

Do not expose the imaging unit to light for more than a few minutes. CAUTION:

Do not touch the exposed drum-roller surface.

5. Remove the orange plug from the back of the imaging unit.

CAUTION:

Once the plug is removed, the imaging unit **must remain level**. If the imaging unit is tipped, contents might spill out.

6. With the right and front doors **fully open**, carefully lift the imaging unit into position so the bottom of the imaging unit aligns with the raised alignment rails inside the printer cabinet (as shown).

CAUTION:

Do not touch the exposed drum roller surface on the imaging unit. Figure : Position the imaging unit so it aligns with the rails inside the printer




7. Insert the imaging unit and push it all the way into the slot. Ensure that it is fully seated.

NOTE:

If the imaging unit binds or does not slide easily into its slot, verify that the right door is fully open, realign the imaging unit, and then insert it again.

Figure : Insert the imaging unit and ensure that it is fully seated




8. Connect the electrical cable (as shown below). Figure : Connect the electrical cable



9. Route the cable into the cable holder (as shown below).

CAUTION:

Make sure the connector is fully seated in the socket. Figure : Route the cable in the cable holder



10.Install two screws (as shown) to secure the imaging unit.

11.Make sure the electrical connector is plugged-in and fully seated, and verify that the two screws are securely installed.
